Philipp Fluri (*1960, Swiss citizen) holds doctorates from the universities of Bern (1987 Dr.phil.hist.) and Fribourg (1990 Dr.phil) and received his *venia legendi* (Dr.habil.) from the university of Pecs in 2009. He also received a Prof. h.c. from Shevchenko University (Lugansk) in 2002.

His career covers both the establishment and management of the think tank/intergovernmental organization *Geneva DCAF Centre for Security Governance* and its Brussels branch, and policy/academic research and teaching.

Before he joined the Kaohsiung-based Wenzao Ursuline University of Foreign Languages he was the Sergio de Mello Chair at Seton Hall University (USA) and an Executive-in-Residence at the Geneva Centre for Security Policy.

His published research covers a vast area of issues at the crossroads of democratic governance, development, and security/defense. A good part of his publications on best practice were written on the mandate of organizations like the Inter-Parliamentary Union, the UNDP, the NATO PA and NATO. They reflect lecturing and research on all continents, including Oceania.

At WZU, Professor Fluri lectures within the DIA department on issues of Cultural Politics, Cross-Cultural Communication, NGO Management, and International Organizations such as the UN and the EU, and Business Ethics and Corporate Social Responsibility.

In 2022/23 he participated in WZU conferences on Russia's war in Ukraine (spring), and the Graduate Institute of European Studies November 2022 international conference with a presentation on EU Migration Policy. He lectured at the George Mason University/Korea Campus seminar on Ukraine in April 2022 and at the Batumi State University Regional Summer Academy on China and Indo-Pacific Security in August 2022. He is currently co-writing a think piece on expectable post-war Organized Crime in Ukraine for the Global Initiative on Organized Crime (with Dr. Marina Caparini, UNU, New York).

In 2024 he participated in several conferences either in person or remotely (below) in Mexico, Ukraine, Georgia, Poland, Denmark and Germany.

Dr. Fluri is an Editorial Board member of *Connections QJ*, *Internal Security*, and *Information and Security International Journal*. In 2024 he also joined *VIAE EDUCATIONS* academic journal as an Editorial Board Member. A special issue on 'Can Democracy be Taught?' is in preparation (2024).
